Description of Service:

Beechwood House is a Residential Rehabilitation Unit for individuals who require treatment for substance misuse issues. Treatment is delivered through Group Work and Key Working sessions. A Community Engagement Programme is also offered. This involves pre-treatment work with substance misusers' families, implementing The CRAFT model. Aftercare is also offered for Service Users leaving the Residential Programme.

Residential Rehabilitation and Community Engagement Programme for people with Substance Misuse issues.

Presently for individuals over the age of 16, this may change to over 18. There is no upper age limit.
