Description of Service: SLCA offer a professional and confidential counselling service for people with substance misuse issues in the Skye and Lochalsh area.

SLCA offer a free, confidential one to one counselling service, support for family members and practical advice and information. This service has now been expanded to youngsters of High School age.

SLCA provide alcohol awareness talks to youngsters at the area's 22 schools, starting at Primary 7. SLCA also offer educational talks to youth groups, community groups and community councils.

SLCA is a registered centre for providing Servewise training courses for licensees and bar staff in partnership with Alcohol Focus Scotland and City & Guilds.

The counselling services are available to anyone over the age of 12. Educational programme starts at Primary 7. Servewise Training courses are available to licensees and anyone working in licensed premises.
