



# Highland MCN Blood Borne Viruses Online Learning

BBV 1000 is the launch of an on-line BBV course in which NHS Highland aim to provide BBV education to 1000 staff across NHS Highland and partner organisations across Highland and Argyll and Bute

## What is the BBV Online Learning Tool and How does it Work?

The BBV online tool, hosted by STRADA, has been designed as part of the NHS Highland "BBV 1000" - an initiative designed to supply BBV training online to at least 1000 members of staff in the Highland and Argyll & Bute regions by March 2011. The course is available to both NHS and non-NHS staff.

The Highland MCN BBV Online learning tool is designed to allow users to access and complete sections at their own pace - either at work or at home - with the module split into concise and manageable learning sections.

## Flexible Learning:

You can choose to leave the Highland MCN BBV online learning area at any time in-between sections and you can return to where you finished off on your next visit.

## BBV Resources:

The online tool also includes a range of BBV related resources in order to provide additional resources of interest to all levels of staff within the Highland and Argyll & Bute regions.

This section is a very useful tool for all services to ensure up to date knowledge on Hep C, Hep B, HIV and BBV and the policies and practices that are relevant to day to day working and service delivery.
