## How we can help



Free **confidential helpline** - 08080 10 10 11 / helpline@sfad.org.uk / webchat available on www.sfad.org.uk. Our advisers will offer listening support and advice to anyone concerned about someone's alcohol or drug use. The helpline is available Monday - Friday between 9am and 11pm and Saturday and Sunday between 5pm and 11pm. Voicemails can be left out of hours and one of our advisers will call you back.



**Telehealth** service which is a series of free one-to-one sessions over the phone, video chat or instant messaging over 6 - 8 weeks and is available across Scotland.



**Bereavement Support** service which offers listening support and advice to family members who have lost a loved one where drugs may have been a reason for their death along with the opportunity to speak to a professional counsellor in their local area. The service is free, offers up to six individual counselling sessions and is available across Scotland.



**Family Support Services** in East Dunbartonshire and Forth Valley offering one-to-one support and family support groups.



We also deliver **Workforce Training and Development Support** to organisations across Scotland. Any enquiries for training should go to training@sfad.org.uk.



We have developed a range of approaches to **Working with Communities**, including our Adult Learning and Empowering Communities (ALEC) toolkit which uses an asset-based community development approach.
